They support nNative students on campus and work with local tribes. What are the challenges facing Native students? Oppressive educational system, invisibility, lack of culturally responsive advising, responsibilities (outside of school), and technology. Leo - HSU has made a commitment to establish and build relationships with Native communities statewide. Tribal resources for students vary significantly. There is considerable diversity within the community. There are aloto of Native students in the CR service areas. HSU team is happy to share resources and collaborate.
