We are writing to confirm that College of the Redwoods faculty and administrators have been working with their counterparts at Humboldt State University to develop a Cannabis Studies curriculum at both institutions that will work toward seamless transfer from the community college to the university in a way similar to how the more formal AA-T degrees work to “guarantee” transfer and completion of a bachelor degree in 60 units or less at the university.

We have held several meetings to discuss the proposed course sequences and lower-division requirements and have devised the associate degree in Cannabis Studies at the college specifically with HSU transfer in mind. We are at the beginning stages of the development of this degree at our institution, but believe that the groundwork has been laid well enough that our degree will serve students when they transfer to complete the Cannabis Studies bachelor degree at HSU.
