Due to the absence of a director for about half the year, most of the planned interventions were not implemented. This outcome will be reassessed again this year, with the new interventions mentioned in section B.

This was an outcome that we wanted to reassess from last year, and because the rate is still below target, we want to reassess it again this year. Strategies will be implemented to help students stay in rigorous courses. One strategy will be to offer online tutoring services which have not be implemented in the past, and to make it mandatory for students with a "C" or below in any class to participate in tutoring. Another strategy, particularly in Del Norte, is to have the Upward Bound Advisor a part of the approval process required to drop a student from a rigorous course. In the past, counselors, students, and parents could drop students without permission from the UB program. With the Advisor involved, less students will be dropped from these courses without our knowledge or consent, and students will be given options and support to stay in those courses.
