In our program review last year, we noted that assessment of outcome #3 was "not as positive as we would have liked", and noted that two possible changes were in progress which might impact this trend — the return of LRC 103 to partial availability for library instruction in Fall 2019, and the implementation of the library's new "Discovery" platform (OneSearch)which we hoped would improve student ability to access and make use of electronic resources, as they would be better integrated with results of searches in the library catalog. While our data are incomplete due to the service interruptions caused by the pandemic, what our statistics seem to show indicates that we may have been right in our expectations about library instruction sessions impacting awareness and use of our online resources. However, we have not been able to see the impact of the discovery system on use of the databases as implementation of the single sign—on system for students is not yet accomplished by IT.

However, the department has continued to make changes to improve student awareness of and access to online library resources. In April, we licensed an upgrade to LibGuides which allowed us to greatly improve the library`s presence in Canvas, making the library much more accessible for online students. Use of library research guides has nearly doubled. We are in the process of realigning our research guides to the college`s academic divisions, which should also improve use and awareness of resources by students and faculty.

Once we are back to "normal" operations we will need to continue our research on the impact of library instruction on student outcomes. Based on the shifting demographics of the district — with continued growth at Pelican Bay and in Distance Education, and a decline in enrollment at Del Norte, we will need to evaluate how the library can best support the changing direction of the college's instructional programs. Since this has a direct impact on instruction throughout the college, it will need to be done with input from the academic senate and administration, as well as faculty college—wide.
