Tentative pick-up day plans*:

- The 20 week share is tentatively planned for **Wednesday** afternoon during the summer.
- Once fall semester begins, the pick-up day for both the 20 and 10 week share is tentatively planned for **Tuesday** afternoon.
- If you are unable to pick up your share during the scheduled pick-up time, **your share will be donated.**
- We put in effort to provide our CSA members with a wide variety of crops throughout the season. This is a fun and challenging part of operating a CSA, and hope that our members enjoy the unique varieties we grow. However, if you only like certain produce we grow at the farm, we suggest you instead shop at our **Campus Farm Stand**. ** We understand that since the pick-up day is not yet finalized, you could sign up and then realize the pick-up time does not work for your schedule.
