



Salary

- Cadet: \$3930 \$5300
- Ranger or Lifeguard: \$5003 \$7330
- Supervisor I (Ranger & Lifeguard): \$6070 \$8249
- Supervisor II (Lifeguard only): \$6645 \$9055

Minimum Requirements

- 60 semester units of college (21 general education)
- Valid CA drivers license
- 21 years of age
- 20/20 vision or 20/40 uncorrected vision
- US Citizen or in process of obtaining citizenship
- Pass a comprehensive background investigation
- Be physically sound
- SPPO Lifeguard: six months open water lifeguard experience



State Park Peace Officer (Cadet)

This is an entry and training level for a law enforcement career with CA State Parks.

No previous law enforcement experience required!





State Park Peace Officer (Lateral)


Red Cross Advanced First-Aid certificate,

Or, First Responder certificate and CPR Certificate

Completion of any accredited Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Basic Training Law Enforcement Academy



Communication Operator



Work as an emergency dispatcher.

Support our officers and help keep park visitors safe.

Minimum Requirements

Education: Equivalent to completion of the 12th grade

Experience: Either

- Six months state service as a Dispatcher-Clerk
- One year in dispatching work involving the operation of radio communications equipment/systems
- Two years with a substantial amount of telephone contact with the public while multi-tasking

Salary

Range A \$3,807-\$5,244 Range B \$4,308-\$5,933



Administrative Positions

- Office Technician
- Staff Services Analyst
- Association Government Program Analyst And many more!

Minimum Requirements will vary for each:

- High school diploma to a degree
- 1 3 years experience

*May substitute years of experience for degree for some classifications.

Salary ranges will vary for each

SPPO Cadet Selection Process

State Park Peace Officer Cadet (Ranger/Lifeguard)



Selection Process Timeline

The entire application process from start to finish takes about 15 months.

April 1

Application

Period Opens

May 13

Mail your application package via postal

✓ STD 678

√ Criminal Background Supplemental Questionnaire

Tip: Include a copy of your transcripts as part of your application package.



Application **Period Closes**

Candidates will receive an emai verifying acceptance to proceed to the next phase.

Applications mailed after due date will not be accepted.



June

P.0.S.T Written Exam

Candidates will take the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) written exam inperson. Candidates will take the exam at one of two locations.

The POST and PAT exams will be held on the same day.



Physical Agility Test

Candidates will receive packets immediately after successfully passing PATs.

Packets must be mailed back as soon as possible to begin the investigation.

July -**February**

Background Investigations

Background Investigators may speak with family, friends, employers, neighbors, coworkers, teachers, and classmates.

March -September

Medical and **Psychological** Assessments

Candidates will receive notification letters on how to proceed mailed to their home.

September -April

Cadet Academy

The academy typically takes 30 - 35 weeks to complete.

Cadets receive salary and benefits!

Application Package

- ✓STD 678- official state application
- ✓ Criminal Record Supplemental Questionnaire
 - Drop-off or mail in
 - postmarked by May 13, 2020
 - official exam bulletin includes the delivery address
 - Copy of unofficial transcripts (HIGHLY recommended)

Status notifications are sent via email. Make sure your contact information on STD 678 is <u>current</u>.





Physical Agility Test (PAT) and Peace Officer Standardize Test (POST)

- POST Written Exam
 - Sample test and study guide on POST website
 - Classroom curriculum is GREAT prep



- Series of elements meant to simulate first responder activities.
- Check out the video.







Background Criminal Review

- Honesty is the BEST policy
- Character evaluation- consideration on a case-by-case basis
- Marijuana- though legal, habitual use is not allowed. No use in the past 12 months minimum.
- Interviews conducted with social circle- friends, family, coworkers, teachers, social media pages, etc.





Medical and Psychological Assessment

<u>Medical Assessment</u>

- Medical History Statement
- Eye Exam
- Physical by licensed physician and surgeon
 - Reviewed by State Doctor

Psychological Assessment

- 3 written psychological tests
- Consultation with a state contracted psychologist

SPPO Lateral / Transfer

Steps

- Create a CalCareers Account
- 2) Take the SPPO Lateral Assessment (Ranger or Lifeguard)
- 3) Apply to the job!

*Note: Note: All applicants must successfully complete the background investigation, medical, psychological, and drug screening prior to their appointment.

Communication Operator

Steps

- Create a CalCareers Account
- 2. Apply to and take the Communication Operator assessment (July & January test dates)
- 3. Apply to the job!



^{*}Note: Individuals who are successful in the examination/selection process and hired as Communications Operators will then be required to complete the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) <u>Public Safety Dispatcher's Basic Course</u> within 12 months of hire or assignment to dispatcher duties.

Steps to Apply



Most state jobs require list eligibility. To ensure you are eligible for hire, take the right assessment.

1. Create an online CalCareers account.

Your application package starts here.

2. Take the assessment.

After successfully completing the exam, you are list eligible and can apply for any vacancies in this classification!

3. Apply!
