

## **Personal Track, English as a Second Language, Certificate of Competency**

A non-credit Certificate of Competency providing instruction in English language skills for personal use to non-native speakers of English at the beginning or intermediate level. The personal track is designed for personal enrichment and focuses on speaking, listening and pronunciation in English for students interested in advancing their communicative ability in the English-speaking world, but without interest in taking credit-level classes. Students who complete the five to seven courses (range depending on beginning ability which is self-determined) will demonstrate the ability to use written and spoken English to communicate in common and specific situations. Students complete five to seven courses for a total of 140-308 hours.

Required Courses:

- **ESL 210 and 211 Intermediate English as a Second Language I and II**
- **ESL 230 and 231 English for Speaking, Listening and Pronunciation I and II**
- **ESL 224 or 225 English Grammar or Popular English**

Optional Courses (for beginner-level students):

- **ESL 200 and 201 Fundamental English as a Second Language I and II**

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## **Academic Track, English as a Second Language, Certificate of Competency**

A non-credit Certificate of Competency providing instruction in English language skills for academic use to non-native speakers of English at the beginning or intermediate level. The academic track is designed for students with an interest in using English for academic purposes and/or pursuing credit courses. This track focuses on reading and writing in English to find information and respond to it. Students who complete the five to seven courses (range depending on beginning ability which is self-determined) will demonstrate the ability to apply English writing conventions as well as common rhetorical moves and mechanical control of the language to respond to ideas in public discourse in writing and for analysis of readings, thus preparing students for successful completion of ENGL 1A. Students complete five to seven courses for a total of 140-308 hours.

El curso académico está diseñado para estudiantes con interés en usar el inglés para propósitos académicos y/o cursos de crédito. Esta pista se centra en la lectura y escritura en inglés para encontrar información y responder a ella. Estudiantes que completan los cinco a siete cursos (El rango depende de la habilidad inicial que es auto-determinada) demostrará la habilidad de aplicar las convenciones de escritura en inglés, así como movidas retóricas comunes y control mecánico del lenguaje para responder a las ideas en el discurso público en la escritura y para el análisis de lecturas, Preparando así a los estudiantes para completar con éxito la ENGL 1A. Los estudiantes completan cinco a siete cursos por un total de 140-308 horas.
