


Hours Spent in the Library






Satisfaction With Library Services and Resources




The library is important to my success as a student.



I find the library comfortable and a good place to work.




The librarians do a good, professional job of providing me information and assistance.




Librarians Instruction On Using Computers To Find Library Materials


The librarians show me how to use the computers to find library materials when I need their help.


Effect Of Library Orientation On Class-Related Research





Answered only if attended Library Orientation: Because my class came to the library for an orientation, I am better able to do my class-related research.












Need For Library Use On Saturday and Sunday

Negative = 32 comments

Quiet/Noise

Negative = 12 comments

- People talk loud sometimes and someone should walk around to make sure people are quiet.
- I wish employees would enforce the no talking/quiet policy in the back study areas. The children allowed to enroll here cannot read signs and have no consideration.
- Sometimes the quiet area needs to be quiet because some students come and talk over there too much.
- Strict enforcement of the rules. No talking on cell phones. No listening to music that is loud. No exposing oneself by having pants fall below the buttocks.
- The library is a good place to work when the quiet/study area is quiet. Many times there are very noisy kids there and it's distracting. The quiet rules should be better enforced.
- Some students (younger) can be very disruptive. When students are loud and disruptive it takes away from other students studies and staff needs to speak with these disruptive students or ask them to leave if they can't abide by library rules.
